Learn to compose for a symphony orchestra and delve into the creative process of composition. You will have the insider opportunity to attend Tucson Symphony Orchestra (TSO) dress rehearsals, meet renowned guest artists and composers, and work with TSO professional musicians. The class culminates in the TSO performing and recording your composition.

Introductory Class begins Fri., Sept. 7, 2018.

Classes meet weekly from 4:30-5:30 pm

Designed for younger students/new composers. Learn the fundamentals of music theory and composition. The final project is a composition for the TSO String Quintet.

Advanced Class begins Sat., Sept. 8, 2018.

Classes meet weekly from 1:00-3:00 pm

Geared towards more experienced students. Learn the principals of harmony, form, score reading, and ear training; compose short works for TSO ensembles performed during class workshops. The final project is a composition for the full Tucson Symphony Orchestra.
